The Caroline County Humane Society (CCHS) will provide free spay and neuter surgeries and rabies vaccinations to pet cats and dogs

belonging to low-income residents of Caroline County.

Summary of Approach:

Applicants are scheduled in order of receipt of application as much as possible. We have limited spaces available at standing Wednesday appointments at Spay Now in Grasonville and the appointments must be balanced with half male, half female surgeries as much as possible. Public using the grant are called to schedule an appointment and given a few opportunities to schedule. If they cannot schedule within a reasonable time we move on to the next in line. Follow up is made to the applicants that missed appointments and they are rescheduled.

Accomplishments:

Our new staff members came onboard in the middle of this project and took over the tasks. Communication with the community has improved.
