Project Synopsis:

It has always been a goal for BARCS to offer free or low-cost veterinary services for low-income pet owners in Baltimore City. For over a decade, BARCS has held our low-cost vaccine clinic on the first Saturday of every month offering low-cost rabies and distemper vaccinations, microchipping and pet licensing to over 3,000 owned pets annually. Our robust Intake Prevention Program has been helping underserved pet owners for more than four years. This program has provided families with numerous resources enabling them to keep their pets. It has helped well over 25,000 pets. And, as funding becomes available, BARCS hosts free community Pet Wellness Days in Baltimore City's most impoverished neighborhoods.
