SECTION THREE

By signing below, the applicant acknowledges that the applicant has read and agrees to the following:

- A sampling Agent must sample industrial hemp lots in accordance with MDA's Field Sampling Guidelines. A sampling Agent must collect samples from the flowering tops of industrial hemp plants that are approximately five to eight inches in length from the main stem, terminal bud, or central cola. A sampling agent must collect a sample that is representative of a homogeneous composition of the lot.
- A sampling Agent must complete a sample collection form and chain of custody form for each sample collected. A Sampling Agent must use the sample collection form and chain of custody form included in the MDA's Field Sampling Guidelines or a form pre-approved by the MDA
- MDA will remove from its list of Trained Sampling Agents or any Sampling Agent who fails to collect samples in accordance with MDA's Field Sampling Guidelines
- MDA is not responsible for a Sampling Agent's operational costs or fees owned by a Registered Industrial Hemp Grower to a Sampling Agent
- All records, data, and information filed in support of a Sampling Agent application are subject to the provisions of the Maryland Public Information Act and are available for review by the public.
